I here by authorise thee to Survey and lay out unto John Simcock one thousand acres upon the North Eastern Side of the Taconey Creek; next unto John Wests Seven hundred acres: next to Jo: Simcock lay out to James Kennerley Six hundred and seventy acres and to returne to mee a true duplicate of the field work and protracted figures which are to remaine in my office dated this 13<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> month 1682
