Situat on ye East side of Scoolkeule begining at a Dogwood tree marked being a corner of ye Reputed Land of Charles ~~Johns~~ Joanes thenc by the said Joanes Line of Marked trees East North East 589 perches to a Chestnut Ok Marked in ye German Town Line from thenc by the Said Line South East and by South 94 perches to a Spruce tree Marked being a Corner of Charles Harfords Land from thenc by a Line of Marked trees & ye same Land West South West 576 perches to a stak Set in ye ground by the River Scoolkeule from thenc by the same North 40 degrees West 96 perches to ye plac of begining Containeing three Hundred twenty Seven acres of Land Resurveyd ye 30th of ye 5th mo 1702 and is according to ye bounds above described Returnd into ye Generall Surveyrs Office at Philadelphia 20th day of ye 1st mo 1703
