

By Vertue of a Warrt from Edward Penington Surveyr Generall bearing date the twelfth day of the eighth month 1700 directed unto me I herby certifie into his office that I have Surveyd and Laid out the 8th of ye 9 mo. En- sueing unto Joseph Pck a Certain tract of Land in the Townshipp of Lim- breck in the County of Philladelphia beginneing at a post by a Street or Roade Running through the Said Townshipp being ~~a~~ in a Line of Jacob Telmore and Companys Land from thenc_ by the said Line of Marked trees South west five hundred perches to a ~~post~~ black ok marked from thenc_ northwest by a Line of marked trees one hundred and sixty perches to a post set in the ground from thenc_ Northeast by a Line of marked trees five hundred perches to a post by the Said Street or Roade from thenc_ by the same Southeast one hun- dred and Sixty perches to the plac_ of begining. Containing and Laid out for five hundred acres of Land
