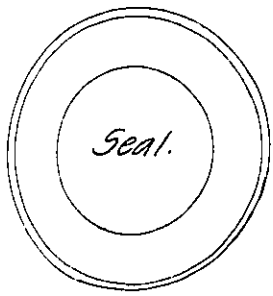

At the Request of Francis Chads that we would grant him a Resurvey on a certain tract of land laid out to him in the Manner of Rocklands by vertue of a Warrant from the former Commissioners of Property for one hundred Acres under the yearly Rent of one bushel of wheat forever which Land the said Francis hath duly seated & improved. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Francis the said tract of land according to its first bounds & true lines of Survey and make returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office where this Warrant is to remain & a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16th of the 12th Moth 1701
