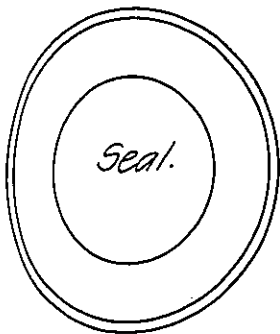


Pennsylvania



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Joseph Cloud Sen^r of the County of Chester that we would grant him to take up one hundred and fifty acres of land in the County of Chester lying between y^e Lands granted by us to Nathani^l Newlin and Henry Gunston for w^{ch} he hath agreed to pay to the Propriet^{rs} Use forty five pounds at or before the 25th of the next month: These are to authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said Joseph Cloud the said Quantity of One hundred and fifty acres in the place aforesaid bounding the same regularly with the lands already Survey'd and Newcastle County Line and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delv'd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 23^d of the 12th Moth 1702
