 Govern<sup>rs</sup> Secretarys office that I have Caused to be Surveyed and Laid out y<sup>e</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup>  
 9<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1684 unto William Dilwin in behalf of Joel Jelson Purchas<sup>r</sup>. A Certain Lott of  
Ground Scituate Lying and being in y<sup>e</sup> City of Philadelphia Containing in Breadth  
 ffifty ffoot, and in length one hundred ffoot Bounded to y<sup>e</sup> Eastward w<sup>th</sup> the Markett Square Southward with a  
 Vacant Lott Westward with y<sup>e</sup> Eighth Street ffrom Schuylkill and to y<sup>e</sup> Northward  
 with W<sup>th</sup> Delwins ~ Lott And is accordingly Entred and Recorded in my Office at  
 Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1686
