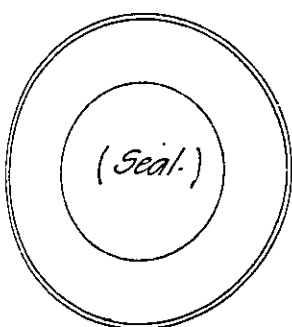


Pennsylvania
