Upon Request of Nathanael Evans yt I would grant him to take up at Rent as Headright Three hundred acres of Land in ye Township next to ye Concord lately layd out in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of Acres in ye aforementioned Place, provided it be not already taken up & according to ye Method appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Chester ye 19th of ye mo. 1682.
