



The draught of Thomas Symmons his Land in the Great Welch Tract in the County of Chester formerly laid out for two hundred acres in part of an Original Purchase of five hundred acres made by his Grandfather Thomas Symmons and Resurvey'd the thirty first day of May Anno 1718 Pursuant to a Warrant from ye Commissioners of Property dated the 30th of the same month and found to contain two hundred twenty two acres.

Certified in my Office and Returned into the Secretary's Office the 2^d of June 1718.
