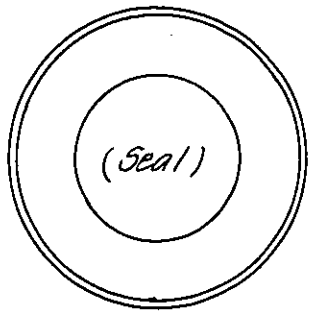

William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern^r in Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties Annexed.

At the Request of Walter ffaucit that I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land in the Township of ~~Chester~~ ^{Ridley} whereon he is now seated reputed to ~~be~~ ^{contain} two hundred acres. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be Resurvey'd the said Tract according to its true present Bounds and Lines of Survey and make returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 4th day of the 1st Moth 170⁹.
