


Pennsylvania.

By Vertue of a warr from y^e Proprietary & Govern^r bearing date the 21st of y^e 12th M^o 1683 (directed to me) I hereby Certify into his Secretary's Office, y^t I have Caused to be Surveyed & set out the 30th of y^e 1st M^o last unto James Delworth Purchaser, his City Lott in y^e high Street, (obliterated - - - - -) Skoolkill; Containing in breadth twenty six foot, & in length three hundred & Six foot; bounded Northward wth back Lotts, Eastward wth a vacant Lott, Southward wth y^e high Street, Westward wth Nicholas Walne's Lott; And is accordingly Entered & Recorded in my Office. Philadelphia this 09th of y^e 5th M^o 1684.
