By virtue of a warr from y^e Proprietary and Govern^t bearing date the 17th of the 4th Month last (directed to me). I hereby Certify into his Secretary's Office, yt. I have caused to be Surveyed and set out unto Francis Dove Purchaser his Lott in the City of Philadelphia the 24th of the said Month Containing in breadth fifty one foot and in length three hundred foot. Scituated between Walnut Street formerly called Pool Street, and Spruce Street formerly called Dock Street; bounded Northward wth W^m Frampton Lott, Eastward wth the second Street ^{from} Delaware Southward wth a vacant Lott, Westward wth back Lotts and is accordingly Entered and Recorded in my Office. Philadelphia the 31st of the 3^d Moneth 1684.
