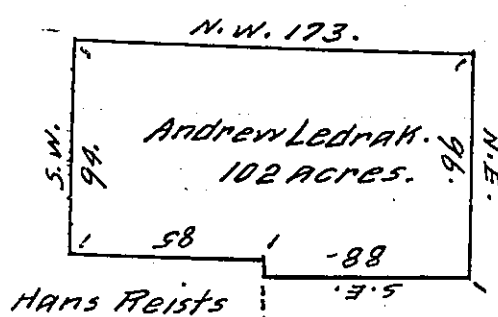


In Pursuance of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property Dated the tenth day of September in the Year 1717. for Surveying to David Powel of Philadelphia Surveyor three thousand acres of Land in this Province There was Surveyd and Set out in December 1717 unto Andrew Ledrah who purchased under the said David Powel a Certain Tract or parcel of Land in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post in Hans Reist's Line Thence running North West by the said— Reist's land eighty five perches to a post Then North East by the same land two perches to a White Oak Then North West by vacant Land eighty eight perches to a post Then South West ninety Six perches to a post Then South East one hundred seventy three perches to a post Then North East ninety four perches to the Beginning Containing One hundred and two Acres.
