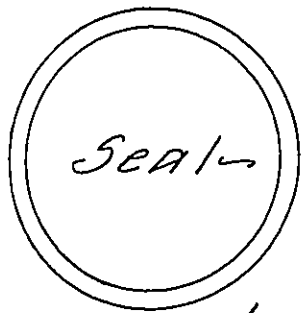


PENNSYLVANIA S.S.

 Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office, Given
 under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadia
 the twelfth day of the fourth Month in the Sixth Year
 of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Queen Anne of
 Great Britain &c. Annoys Domini. 1707.
