



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 22d. of 9br. 1717. I Survey'd to Thomas Lower a Certain Tract of land Situate on a Branch of Swahatawro Creek in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a white oak in a Line of a Tract of land Surveyd for the Proprys. Use thence by the Same and Vacant Land North 10d. West 522 pches to a white oak thence South 80 d. West by Vacant land 400 pches to a post thence South 10.d. East by Vacant land 522 pches. to a post thence North 80d. East by Vacant land 400 pches to the place of Beginning Containing twelve hundred and thirty acres and the Allowance of Six acres p. Cent.
