Directed to me I here by Certifie into his secretaryes  
office yt I have caused to be Surveyd and set out ye 5th. of  
ye 11th. MO<sup>—</sup> 1683. unto Jno. Luff Renter a Lott in ye City of  
Philadelphia. Containing in Breadth fourty foot and in  
Length one hundred ninty Eight foot. Bounded northward  
wth. A vacant Lott Eastward wth. Back Lotts Southward  
wth. Walnut Street westward wth ye third street from  
Skoolkill — and is Accordingly Entred and Recorded in  
my office, Philadelphia this 15th. of ye 5th. MO. 1684.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
