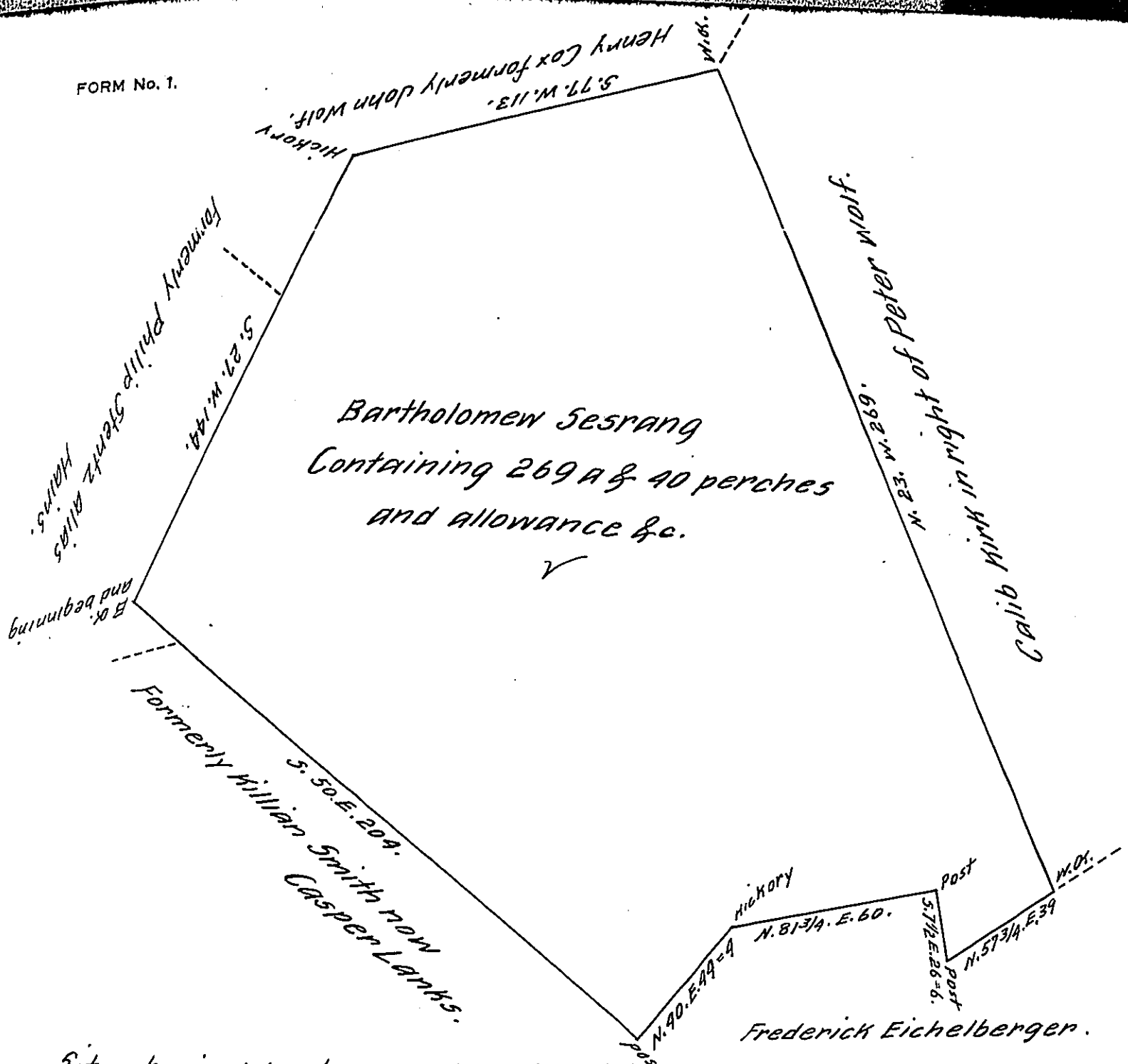


FORM No. 1.



Situate in Westmanchester Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 269 A & 40 perches and allowance &c. Originally Surveyed on the 22d. day of October A.D. 1750. by George Smith late D.S. under George Stevenson late D.S. in Pursuance of a Warrant for 200 A. Granted to Bartholomew Sesrang bearing date the 8th. day of January A.D. 1742. Resurveyed by the old lines by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 16th. day of December A.D. 1793. And now at the request of the Present owners viz John Dobbin and William Harris I am desired to make return of the draught as Calculated examined &c. the 8th. day of July Anno Domini 1809.
