he fencing ym in, clearing ye same, & building upon ye  
front Lott within six Months from ye Date of Survey & make  
returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Phila-  
delphia ye 25<sup>th</sup>. <sup>5<sup>th</sup></sup>/<sub>mo.</sub> 1684.*
