In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th day of October 1760 requiring Nicho. Scull Esqr. then Surveyor General to Survey for the Hon. Proprietaries all the Islands in the Diff. Rivers & Creeks in the province purchas'd of the Indians. There was Surveyed for them Two Certain Islands in the River Schuylkill in the County of Philada the uppermost of wch lies above Reese Ap Edwards's Ford & is opposite the Land ~~of~~ of David Davis & Hugh Roberts on the west side of sd River Containing Four acres. The other of them lies below the said Ford & is opposite the Lands of John Llewellyn on the west side of sd River. Containing One Acres & one hundd. & thirty seven perches Returned into the Secretaries Office the 6th day of April. 1762. 1762.
