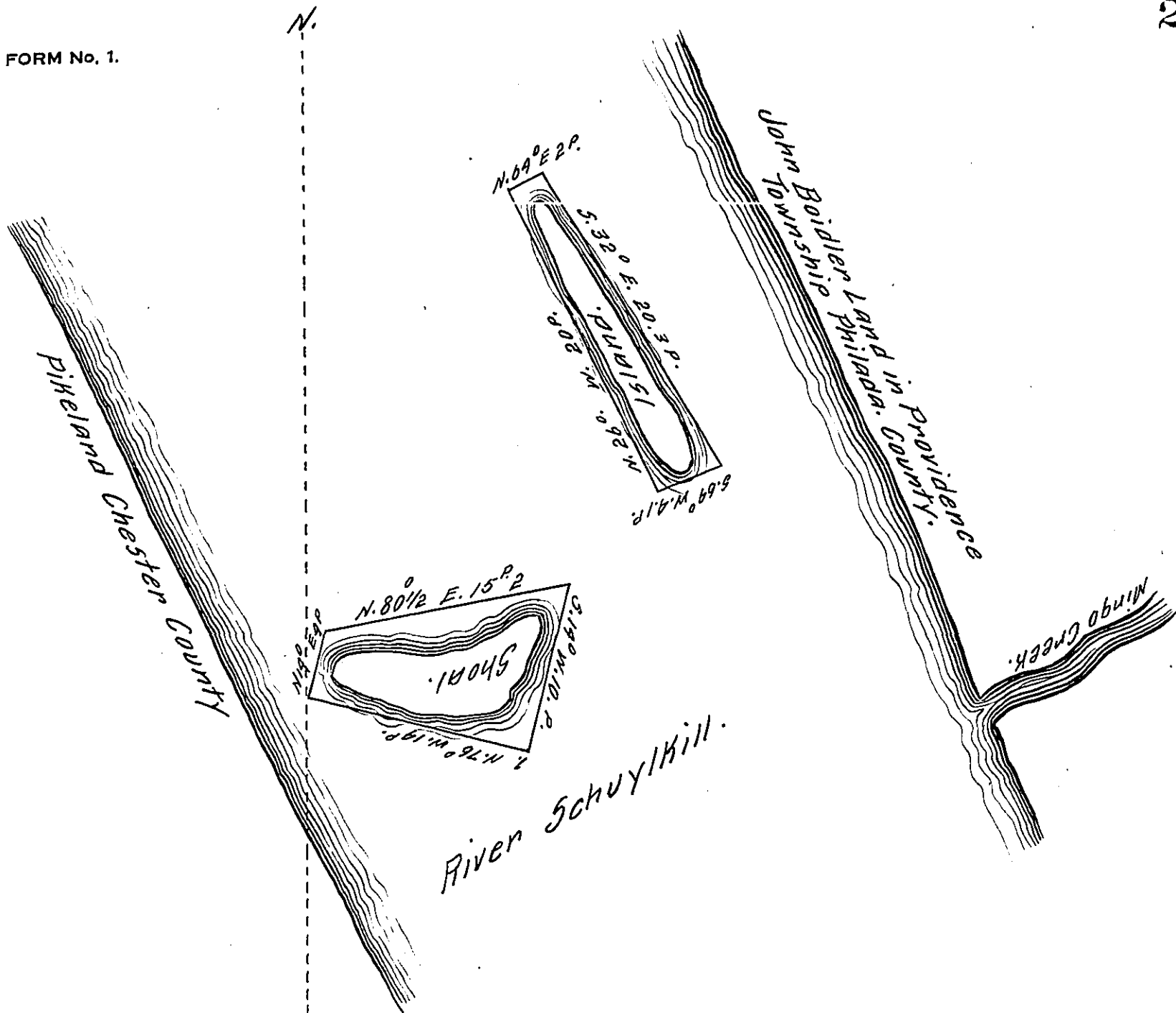

 scribed Island and Shoal for John Boidler in Right of
 Samuel Bell, the Island with Gravel round it I find contains
 60 Perches & 3 tenths strict Measure the Shoal 98 P. like
 Measure.

The Island is the next above the mouth of Mingo Creek in
 the River Schuylkill & the Shoal opposite to the Island as
 appears by the Draughts.
