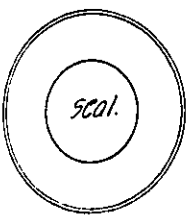


Pennsylvania ss.

These are to Authorize and Require thee to surveyor cause to be survey'd in the Right aforesd., according to the Method of Townships appointed by the Propriet^r the said quantity of ~~one~~ five hundred Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is conceal'd nor seated by the Indians, and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 26th day of the second Month 1707.
