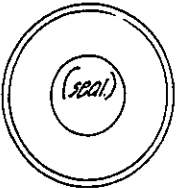


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Richard Webb, That we would Grant him to take up five hundred acres of Land Purchased of the Proprietor by Sam^l Hardy of Badslly in Hampshire Clerk by Deeds dated ye 2^d & 3^d dayes of April, 1686 under the Yearly Rent of one Shilling Sterling for ye whole, and by Several mesme Conveyances now come to the said Richard & Elizabeth, his Wife. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd to the said Richard Webb & Elizabeth according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred Acres of Land that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our Hands & Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 20th of the 4th moth, 1712.
