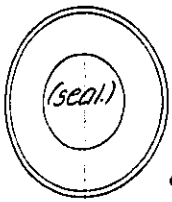


Pennsylvania

These are to Authorize and Require Thee to Resurvey according to the Lines by which the Tracts were at first laid out for or Granted or according to the Boundaries of the ~~present~~ present possessions as it shall be most Convenient, All the Lands scituate within the Bounds of that tract in the County of Philadelphia ~~at~~ at first laid out for and known by ye name of Whitpains Township with all the Lands since cutt off ye same. Also all the Tracts and parcels of Land scituate in the sd County above the Township of Gwynedd, and all the lands between the sd Township and the Division Line of the sd. County from ye County of Bucks adjoining. Also all the Tracts and several parcels of Land scituate between the Westermost Bounds of Germantown and the River Skuylkill, Also to prove the Outlines of the sd. Germantown and to prove & new mark the Lines of the Proprietors Mannor of Springfield in the sd County and make Returns either of ye whole or in such parcels as thou shalt hereafter be required into the ^{General} Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain & a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary.
