

In pursuance of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 20th. day of the third Month, 1726 There was Resurveyed on the 23^d of the third Month 1727 unto Rees Thomas & Anthony Morris a Tract of Land in Whitpain's Township in the County of Philadelphia formerly laid out for four thousand and five hundred acres viz: fifteen hundred acres in Right of the Proprietary's Grant to Samuel Fox One thousand acres in Right of James Claypoole and Two thousand acres in Right of Charles Marshal the Right to all which being now Vested in the said Rees Thomas and Anthony Morris The whole Beginning at a Corner of Isaac Norris' Land in a Line of (ob) Wales Thence by the said Line South forty seven degrees East one thousand three hundred twenty eight perches Then by the Lands of Harmer and Daws South forty three Degrees West four hundred seventy two perches Then North West by the Lands of John Rennox, John Davis, Henry Conrad, Peter Endehaven, Willm. Robinson and Thomas Fitzwater Nine hundred sixty eight per² Then by the said Fitzwater's Land South West four hundred eighty four perches Then by the said Isaac Norris' Land call'd ye Mannor North forty six degrees West three hundred seventy four perches Then North East by the said Isaac Norris's Land Nine hundred and four perches perches to the place of Beginning Containing four thousand eight hundred fifty eight acres.
