By vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary bearing date ye 12th of the 7th mo, 1683 to me directed, I do hereby Certifie into ye Secret^{ys} office that there was surveyd & laid out the 19th of the 5^d sequenth moe, 1683 unto Joseph Wassey purchaser, a Certaine peice of Land Scituate Lying & being in the Dublin Township & Couty of Philadelphia, begining at a corner past of Walter Kings Land, Thence N:E: by the same four hundred and Eighty fches from thence S:E: by the Susquehanna Street or Road Eighty three fches & 9^q Thence S:W: by Robert Faireman's land foure hundred & Eighty fches from thence North west by a line of trees Eighty three fches & 9^q to the place of begining containeing two hundred & fifty acres of Land w^{ch} is accordingly Entred & Recorded in ye Surv^{ys} Gen^{ls} office at Philadelphia ye 24th month, 1694.
