At the Request of Andrew Wheeler of Miamensen in the County of Philadel-
 phia That we would grant him a Resurvey on his Plantation in Miamensen afores^d
 consisting of one fourth part of one Tract of fast Land containing five hundred
 and twenty five Acres and two parcels of Meadow containing in the whole Sixty
 three Acres, the other three parts being held by Andrew Bankson, John Stille
 and W^m Wells or y^e Widow Nailor: These are to Authorize and Require thee
 exactly to Resurvey to the s^d Andrew Wheeler his s^d Plantation & Land
 thereunto belonging according to its known Bounds and ancient Lines of
 Survey: Also to lay out therewith fifty Acres of Marsh granted to the s^d
 Andrew by y^e Prop^{rs} Warr^t directed to Edw^d Penington in the 8th moth
 1701 and make Return of y^e whole into y^e General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia}
 where this warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by
 y^e Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia}
 26th 11^{mo}, 1702.
