



By the Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup>'s Order Layed out unto Joseph Wasey two hundred and Fifty acres of Land situate on the begining of the second Dublin Towne-ship in the County of Philodelphia. Begining at a corner post of Robert Fairman's Land and thence by the same four hundred and Eighty perch-North East to a post for a Corner Thence north west by the susquehanna Roade Eighty Three perch-and a halfe to a post for another Corner Thence south west by the Land late belonging to Walter King four hundred and Eighty perch-to a post for another Corner, Thence south west by the Land late belong- ing to Nehemiah Mitchell Eighty three perch-and a halfe to the first mention- ed corner post q<sup>d</sup>: 250°: aforesaid.
