hundred & fifty Acres, yt I would grant him to take up his Proportion of
Land wthin ye Liberties of ye City: These are to will & require thee Forth
wth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him Twenty five Acres wthin
ye Bounds thereof, where not already taken up according to ye method
of Townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Sec-
retary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 17th 5^{mo}, 1683.
