By virtue of a warrant from ye Com<sup>rs</sup> dated ye — of ye — m<sup>o</sup> 169 — directed to ye Survey<sup>r</sup> General, I do by Authority From him Certifie into ye Secretaryes Office that there was surveyed and Laid out the same day unto Robert Whitton in Right of Rob<sup>t</sup> Lodge, Purchase of Five Hundred acres, his Lott in ye Liberties of Philadelphia Beginning at a forme post of Dennis Rochford's Land Thence .N.N.W by ye same Thirty Two perches thence W.S.W. by A Line of trees Forty perches to a forme post From thence S.S.E. by A Line of trees Thirty Two perches From thence E.N.E. by A Line of marked trees Forty perches to the place of beginning Containing Eight acres of Land which is accordingly Entred and Recorded in ye Survey<sup>r</sup> General's Office at Philadelphia ye 10<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup>, 169<sup>9</sup>.
