Whereas William Wood hath bought of me one hundred acres of Land with ye Liberties, adjoyning to ye Land Lay'd out already for him out of ye overplus Land of John Bowles. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be Surveyd into him ye sd Number of Acres, from ye sd William Woods Line downe, <sup>to</sup> ye Rhonda, <sup>containing fifteen chain</sup> contouring two cote paces of front, & ye rest in Length to make up ye complement of ye sd hundred Acres, he Seating & improving ye same, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadelphia, ye 27<sup>th</sup> of ye mo. <sup>4th</sup>, 1684.
