At the Request of John Wright late of Manchester in Great Britain but now of Chester in this Province: that We would Grant him to take up the Lott of Ground within this City and the Liberty Land belonging to William Gibsons purchase of five hundred Acres of Land ^{made of ye Proprietor to be laid out} in this Province which is now Vested in the said John Wright. These are to authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out or cause to be Survey'd and Laid out unto the Said John Wright within the said City the said Lott of ground and the Liberty Land within the Liberties thereof Proportionably to the said Purchase that have not been already surveyed nor appropriated and make a Return of Each part into the Secretary's Office in order to a further Confirmation. Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 26th day of the 2^d Month Anno Dni, 1716.
