

Philad<sup>a</sup>. March 5<sup>th</sup>, 1774.

Sir:

John Faller desires to purchase from the Hon<sup>o</sup> the Proprietaries thirty five Acres of Land adjoining Lands occupied by Nicholas Houchey, Matthias Brug, Johannes Zeller and Jacob Bratzman in Williams Township in Northampton County (within four Miles of Easton, as it is said) Part of the Reserved Lands: You are therefore desired to furnish me with a Draught and at the same time to inform me of the Quality of the Land so applied for.
