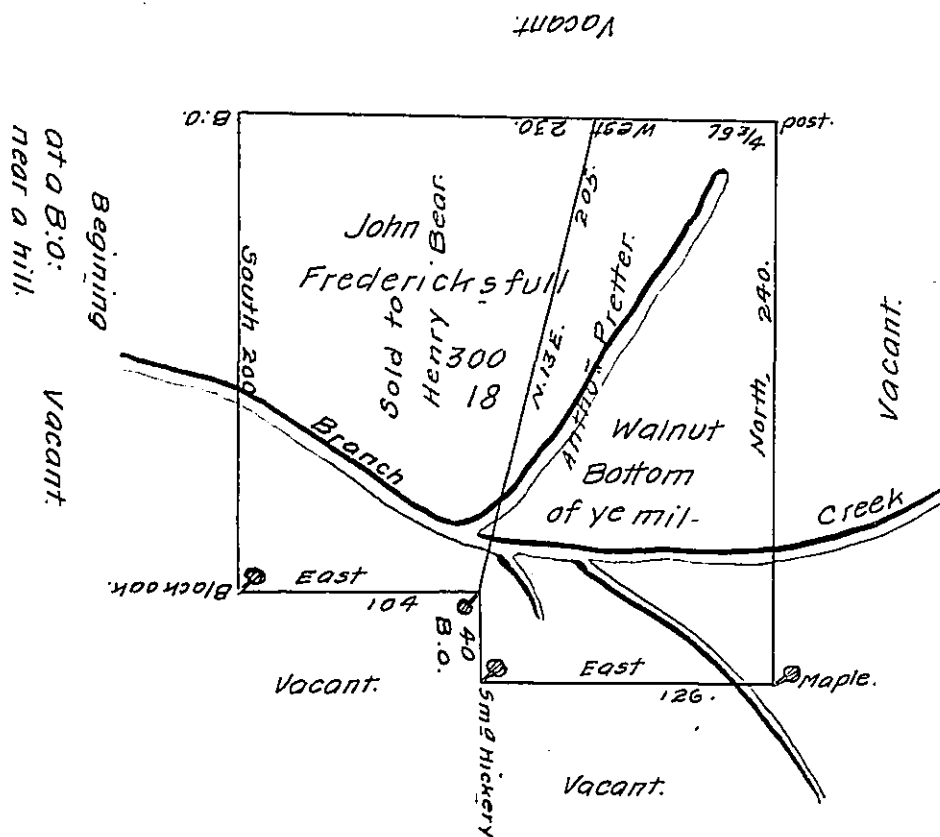


FORM NO 1.

John Frederick Full and Anthony Preter have agreed to divide the Tract of 300 acres Equally by a line drawn from the Black oak after E. 104 to the Line west 230.



Warrant to Jno Frederick Fulls for 300^{ac} dated the 20th of the third month 1717

John Fredricksfull's Land Survey'd August the 21st 1717.

Jno. Frederickfuls by Deed dated the 4th March 1736 hath granted 150^{ac} to Antho^m Preter as divided by the above Draught Returned &c. y^e 11th of March 1736-7.
