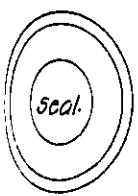


Pensilvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Christopher Franciscus of Strasburg Township in this Province that we would Grant him to take up in or near the Said Township the quantity of Two hundred acres of Land for which he agrees to pay to the Prop^{ts} use Twenty Pounds Mony of Pensilvania for the whole & the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for each hundred Acres These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Christopher Franciscus at the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of Two hundred acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office which Survey in case the Said Christopher fulfill the above agreement within three months after the date hereof Shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philadelphia ye 5th of ye First Month Anno Dni. 1717/8.
