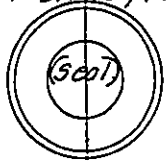


Pennsylvania ss.

Secretary's Office for our Use Ten thousand Acres of Land in one or more Tracts on the waters of Lehawaxen, some part thereof to include the Waters of Big Middle Creek being the first Westerly Branch of Lehawaxen emptying in above Wallanpapack in the County of Northampton and in so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
