John Musser, 300 Acres, adjoining on the East side to Land this day granted to Robert Lettis Hooper, Jun<sup>r</sup> in North<sup>a</sup> County.

Anth<sup>y</sup> Seyfert, 300 Acres adjoining on the Southerly side to land this day granted to John Musser in North<sup>a</sup> County.

John Cox 300<sup>as</sup> nearly adjoining to land this day granted to Anthony Seyfert in Northampton County.

Robert Roberts 300 Acres adjoin<sup>g</sup> to Land this day granted to John Cox in North<sup>a</sup> County.


