



By Virtue of an Order dated the 3^d of June 1773 and surveyed the 27th of May, 1777 to Leonard Heuckle the above Described Tract of Land situate in the H(obl.)ble the Proprietaries appropriated Land in Maccungy Township Northampton County Containing Forty four Acres sixty perches and the Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. & C^o. being all barren Land of a thin Soil.
