



At ye Request of Joseph Willcox made a Reasurvey on a certaine pece of Land in ye Bristol Township in ye County of Philadelphia between ye Land he formally sould to Samuel Richardson and yt he sould to James Delworth begneing at a Cor<sup>r</sup> of sd<sup>d</sup> Richardsons Land from thence North by anould Line of Marked trees 190 perches to a post in a Line of Delworth's Land: Thence South 60 degrees East by ye said Delworth Line of Marked trees 54 perches to a stak. by a smalobl. Sapline Marked; thence by <sup>an oulder</sup> Line of Marked trees deviding it from Robert Heath's Land: South by west 172 perches to a stak. in ye <sup>Line</sup> of Joseph Willcox other Land thence by ye said Land weste by north 50 perches to ye place of begineing. Containing 56 1/2 acrs according to ye above described figure Reasurveyd ye 31<sup>st</sup> of ye 11<sup>mo</sup>. 1703/4.
