Acres. And since survey'd off the same one hundred  
Acres to Sam<sup>l</sup> Richason And to Jas. Dillworth two hun-  
dred Acres Both which I also resurvey'd the last  
Survey and found them to containe their just quantetyes  
And what was left betwixt the lands so by him sold  
to said Richason & Dellworth I did also againe with  
David Powell Survey the same and found it to con-  
taine as on the other side, Wittnest my hand this  
31<sup>st</sup> of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 1703/4.
