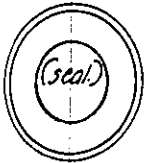


Pennsylvania ss.

By the Commission<sup>rs</sup> of Property.



Upon an agreem<sup>t</sup> made with Evan William of this Province for a Tract of Land situate near Perqueominck in y<sup>e</sup> County of Philadelphia formerly laid out to Adam Birch but since deserted reputed to contain five hundred Acres for which the said Evan is to pay to the Proprietor within twelve Months after the date hereof after the Rate of five and twenty pounds & ~~for every hundred Acres~~ of such Money as Debts contracted before the first day of May next shall generally be discharged in, in this Province, for every hundred Acres of the said Land together with Interest for the same to commence within three months after the date hereof. These are to Authorize and Require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be survey'd to the s<sup>d</sup> Evan William the said Tract of Land according to the former Bounds thereof, and make Returns into the Secretaries Office which Survey to be by thee made in case the s<sup>d</sup> Evan shall comply with the agreem<sup>t</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> be valid & good otherwise shall be void and of no effect as if the same had never been made nor this warr<sup>t</sup> ever granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the first Month (March) A.D. 170 8/9.
