These are therefore in ye Proprietary's name to will and require thee Forth with to Survey and Lay out unto him A peece of land at ye north east part of ye towne in ye Front fifty foot and running From ye Front Street to ye Third Street Continueng ye Said Breadth of Fifty Foot being about one thousand Foot in Length; And make returnes thereof into ye Secretaryes office dated at Philadelphia ye 15 of 9 ber. 1690.
