By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Joseph Jarvis of the County of Chester in this Province That we would Grant him to take up the proportion of Liberty Land appurtenant to One Thousand Acres purchased of the late Proprietr. by John Marsh of Aether Hayford in the County of Oxford in Great Britain by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 11th & 12th dayes of October Anno 1681 who since sold the whole unto the said Joseph Jarvis. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said Joseph Jarvis within the Liberties of Philadelphia where the same may be found vacant the said proportion of Liberty Land that has not been already Survey'd nor is Lawfully claimed by any other person and make Return thereof into the Secretarys Office in order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 20th day of December Anno Dni. 1727.
