



In pursuance of a warrant from the Commissrs. of Property Dated the 21st of the 3^d Month 1719. Surveyd and Laid out the 28th Day of the first 1720 unto James Steel in Right of Joseph and Daniel Miller* their Original Purchase of 250 A. One Lot of Ground in the City of Philadelphia. Bounded Northward with a Lot reputed vacant Eastward with the Ends of the Second. Street Lots Southward with a Lot Laid out to Samuel Finney and on the west with the third Street from Delaware being in Breadth on the said Third Street Sixty Seven foot and a half and in Length One hundred Ninety five ft. Returned into the Secretary's Office this Second Day of April Anno Domini. 1720.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Second day of August 1910
