



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated ye 26th day of March 1733 Surveyed to James Steel in right of a Certain Tract of Land Situate Near Newcowissohoppin in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post thence North by Vact Land Ninety one perches and by Land of Ulrich Rasors, and Vacant Land two hundred and Nineteen perches to a post thence by Vacant Land East one hundred and fifty one perches to a white oak thence by Vacant Land South three hundred and ten perches to a post thence by Vacant Land West one hundred and fifty one perches to the place of Beginning. Containing two hundred and Seventy five Acres with the usual Allowance of six p Cent.
