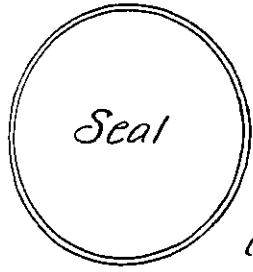

the said parcel fifty Acres to William Harman or his Assigns Sold  
by the S<sup>d</sup> David to the S<sup>d</sup> Harman and now in Peter Clevers  
Possession and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office  
at Philadelphia where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof  
to be deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take <sup>a</sup>  
Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under Our hands  
and the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 30<sup>th</sup> of the first Month 1702
