 of marked trees North East five hundred perches to a post Sett in
 the ground, from thenc North West by a Line of marked trees One
 hundred and Sixty perches to another post Sett in the ground, from thenc
 by Line of marked trees ~~West~~ South West five hundred perches to a
 post in the Said Street or Roade and by the Same South East One
 hundred and Sixty perches to the plac^e of beginneing Containeing
 and Laid out for five hundred acers of Land.
