October the 25th Anno 1717 Resurveyed and measured for Samuel Powel two Lotts in his Possession in the City of Philadelphia as also a Contiguous piece of Vacant Ground by him now purchased or to be purchased of the proprietary Viz

1st One Lott in Right of Anthony Elton Bounded Westward with the Third Street from Delaware, Northward with Thomas Pascals Lott Thomas Bradfords Lott and a Lot called the Brewhouse Lott, Eastward with the Second Street Lotts and on the South with the other of the above said two lotts (next hereafter mentioned) being in Breadth fifty one foot and in Length One hundred Ninety Six foot.

2^d One Lott ⁱⁿ Right of John Wall and John Wallis Bounded Westward with the ^{sd} Third Street Northward with the lott above described Eastward with the Second Street Lotts and Southward with the aforesaid Vacancy being in Breadth forty nine foot and a half and in Length One hundred Ninety Six foot.

3^d The Said Piece of Vacant Ground Bounded Westward with the Said Third Street Northward with the Lott Last above described Eastward with the Second Street Lotts and Southward with another Lott of the Said Samuel Powel being in Breadth thirty three foot and in Length One hundred Ninety Six foot.
