



By virtue of a warrant from Edward Pennington Surveyor General directed unto me bearing date ye 5 day of ye 2^d mo 1701, I hereby Certify into his Office that I have Resurveyed unto William Palmor a Certain tract of Land in a Township Called Whittpaines in the County of Philadelphia beginning beginning at a Stake Set for a Corner neere a Hickry marked deviding it from Elizabeth Jacksons Land; from thence by a line of marked trees and same Land North East 466 perches to another Stake Set in the ground from thence South East by a Line of marked trees and sd Whittpains Land 286 perches to a Stake being a Corner deviding it from John Palmors Land, from thence by a Line of marked trees South West 466 perches to another Stake deviding it from sd John Palmors Land; from thence North West by a Line of marked trees by plimouth Township 286 perches to the place of beginning, Containeing and Laid out for Eight hundred & thirty two Acres of Land & 156 perches.
