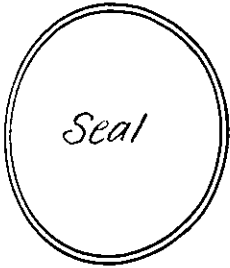

the Province of Pensilvania and Counties Annexed.*

*At the Request of Christopher Pennock That I would grant him to
have Surveyd ~~to him~~ two Hundred Acres of land formerly laid out
to him upon ye River Skuykill and Situate between the Land of
William Sherlow and Morgan Davis, These are to will and Require
thee forthwith to Survey again or cause to be Surveyd to him the
Said Number of Acres out of the Said Tract, and make Returns
thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand
and Seal at Philadelphia the 29th day of ye 4th month AD. 1700*
