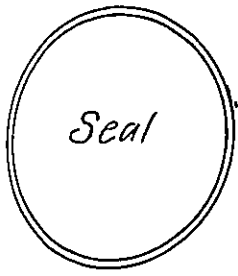

Upon an Agreement made with John Parsons of Philadelphia Carpenter for a certain Vacant Lott on the North Side of Walnut Street adjoining on the Western Side of the Dock Crossing the Said Street in the City of Philadelphia ~~in~~ ^{on} Delaware Side, ~~Philadelphia~~ These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and Lay out to the Said John Parsons the above described Lott exactly under its Dimensions on each side leaving the Dock Street clear as at first laid out, to be held by the S^d John for the Space of twenty one years under the Yearly Rent of an English Crown to be paid in the first month of every Year of the S^d term to the Proprietary & then to revert to him & his Heirs as their former & proper Estate & make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain & a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee Certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{la} the 20th of the 12th Moth 1704.
